Bidders, submitting their bid electronically, should deposit the cost(as specified above) of bidding document in the account as specified below and the scanned copy (pdf format) of the Bank deposit voucher shall be uploaded by the bidder at the time of electronic submission of the bids. The Technical Bid and Financial Bid shall be sealed in two separate envelopes and clearly marked as Technical Bid and Financial Bid & both bids shall be sealed in a single envelope and sealed and marked as Bid in the form of Hard copy or electronic bids in the form of Technical Bid and Financial Bid.
6. Sealed or electronic bids must be submitted to the office Nepal Oil Corporation Ltd., Babrmahal or through PPMO website www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp on or before 12:00 hrs on **2073/12/21**. Bids received after this deadline will be rejected. Those who choose to submit the sealed bids (offline) also should register in PPMO's website www.bolpatra.gov.np/egp before deadline for bid submission.
7. The bids will be opened in the presence of Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at 14:00 hrs on **2073/12/21** at the office of Nepal Oil Corporation Ltd., Babrmahal. Bids must be valid for a period of 90 days after bid opening and must be accompanied by a bid security or scanned copy of the bid security in pdf format in case of e-bid, amounting to a minimum of **Rs. 12,50,000.00**, which shall be valid for 30 days beyond the validity period of the bid.
8. If the last date of purchasing and /or submission falls on a government holiday, then the next working day shall be considered as the last date. In such case the validity period of the bid security shall remain the same as specified for the original last date of bid submission.
9. Bids should comply in all respects with the instructions to bidder included in the bid document. Non compliance with these instructions will result in disqualification.
